Pursuant to Chapter 1, Article 1, Section 5 of the Regulations, all past and present officers of the subject Camp are to turn over to the Department of Pennsylvania any and all properties of said Camp including but not limited to the camp charter and all funds, bank accounts, and holdings belonging to aforementioned Camp.
