New charter presented for a new Camp in the **Department of Texas**

Last Veteran in the County grave markers are not eligible for grants from National Civil War Memorial Grant Fund

Per the National Site Selection Committee: 2019 – Independence, Ohio (just south of Cleveland) 2020 – Atlanta, Georgia 2021 – No final decision, however Missouri being considered

The National Site Selection Committee requested and received \$2,500.00 line item in the 2018-2019 budget to reimburse expenses in reviewing National Encampment hosting proposals.

After interest expressed by DUVCW, the Nat Encampment Site Committee Chair directed to establish a line of communication with the DUVCW with the view of considering joint Convention/Encampments starting 2021

CinC Special Committee to be formed to identify financial requirements, including facility and staffing, necessary to establish a National Headquarters of sufficient size to accommodate the Executive Director and Quartermaster functions under one roof. To be chaired by Council Member Kevin Tucker, PDC.

Webmaster and Signals Officer working on finding vendors to re-design the website. To that end, the Encampment approved budget line items of \$5,000 for web development in the second half of the fiscal year ending 2019 and to consider an additional \$10,000 in the first half of the fiscal year ending 2020.

Departments that fail to submit reports for the National Encampment will not be allowed to provide a verbal report at a National Encampment without special approval of the CinC.

Spring Council of Administration meeting will be at Springfield, Illinois and in conjunction with Lincoln Death Day observances

National Treasurer shall forward shortly the appropriate form for Departments and SVR Districts to certify General Order 18, Series of 2017-2018, has been fully complied with by all Camps and SVR units.

Protocol, Customs and Courtesies document completed, adopted by the Council of Administration and will be posted to the website.

No change in the National Member-at-Large annual dues and the life member reimbursement amount.
