# STEPHENSON MEMORIAL PLAZA PHASE ONE



When the good Brothers and Sisters of our Orders arrived at the Rose Hill Cemetery at Petersburg, Illinois on Saturday, April 15, 2017, they found the Doctor Benjamin F. Stephenson gravesite looking very different. The Phase One of the Stephenson Memorial Plaza is complete. The signature bricks and memorial benches are all engraved and put in place.

Phase Two will include the extension of signature bricks around the cannon and monument to include the placement of new flagpoles on each side of the monument, one for the National flag and the other for the State flag.

Phase Three completes the southern edge of the Plaza with signature bricks and room for more memorial benches and the informational wall. Solar panels will be installed to illuminate the monument, flags and informational wall. The entire plaza will be bordered with a dark border stone and black Bollards with heavy chain draped between to serve as a barrier.
